


Where can languages take YOU?

In high school, you can continue with French or Spanish, or start German, Italian, Chinese, Russian, Latin, or American Sign Language.


You can start French or Spanish in 7th or 8th grade.


Plus, learning a language makes you smarter!



Language learners have higher test scores, better memory, and more gray matter in their brains! "But, don't most people in the world speak English?"
1) Is English the native language of most people?
2) Which native language is most spoken in the world?

3) What percentage of the world speaks English as their first language?








And the answers are...

1) Do most people in the world speak English as their first language? *Nope*

2) Which native language is most spoken in the world? Mandarin Chinese is 1st (14.4% of the world's population). Spanish is 2nd (6% of the world's population).

3) What percentage of the world speaks English as their first language? English is 3rd (only 5% of the world's population).

In the U.S., 20% of people are now bilingual, and it's growing fast!



However, in Europe, more than half (50%) of the population is bilingual or even <u>multi</u>lingual.
